Working Group Activities/Outcomes/Progress to Date	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Pilot has moved into an initiative and includes a Steering Committee. • Publications/Communications: Final Pilot Report, Press Release, NCURA Article, NCURA regional meetings with more requests for publicity coming • Almost all FDP members have joined the Expanded Clearinghouse - 200 profiles total to-date! • Sample pushback language has been updated and is available on the website. • Website has been updated <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pilot information is being archived • Instructional videos are available for the Expanded Clearinghouse with a few more coming • Significant codebase updates, though users will not see any changes, in order to improve maintainability and sustainability • Data Export feature extensively reviewed but will not be offered <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Duplicates API functionality ○ Reduces references to website, increases risk of old/bad data ○ Enhanced search tools will be coming to the website in the future • API will go live this month <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 3 tokens have been issued to Beta testers ○ Access may be requested through the Data Access tab on a published profile • Financial Questionnaire <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Current list on FDP website is exhaustive and is being consolidated ○ Progress to-date <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Goal to create a document that is widely usable ▪ Creating a survey to be sent to Pass through Entities to get a better understanding of interest and challenges
Agenda/Discussion Points for this Meeting	<p>Future planning, stabilizing and standardizing the Clearinghouse processes.</p> <p>Where do you struggle in keeping up your profile? Areas highlighted as reminders for profile maintenance/updating:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SAM Registration – make it part of your processes to update the Expanded Clearinghouse when SAM is updated • Audit Section – Add the new audit and then move the previous year’s audit to “Single Audit Report from previous Fiscal Year” field. • Contacts Section – please keep these updated • Current data needed at all times in Profiles to ensure integrity



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- Creating escalation processes
- Internal issues due to decentralization
 - Example, when SAM is updated by one person, that action may not be communicated to the Expanded Clearinghouse contact; suggestion to copy other Profile contacts so the other person would be notified when expiration date is approaching
- Some assurance expirations aren't being renewed by government entities on time
 - Suggestion is for users to update the profile with Comments that the assurance is out of date, but that the institution is waiting on the governmental entity
- As users find out-of-date data, contact the institution to let them know that their information is out of date.
- Data Analysis
 - Scrubbing the data to look for consistency among administrative reviews and how fields were answered
 - How the data can benefit FDP as a whole? (**not meant to replace organizational subrecipient monitoring requirement)
 - Data could be used to help demonstrate the need for a Single Audit Safe Harbor
 - What do organizations think about the data being used to support FDP in this fashion?
 - Other Suggestions for ways to analyze data that might be helpful?
 - Clarify certain questions such as audit findings in R&D Section vs. overall.
 - Form for enhancement requests (for now, send ideas to fdpechelp@gmail.com)
- Financial Questionnaire Thoughts?
 - Audience response – must reduce administrative burden
 - AQ: Would FQ be shared? R: That is to be determined
 - AQ: Can we see a draft before participating? R: Yes
 - AQ: Please send on subaward listserv, in addition to EC listserv. R: Lynette noted that she foresees the FQ pilot following the same path as the Expanded Clearinghouse with cohorts
