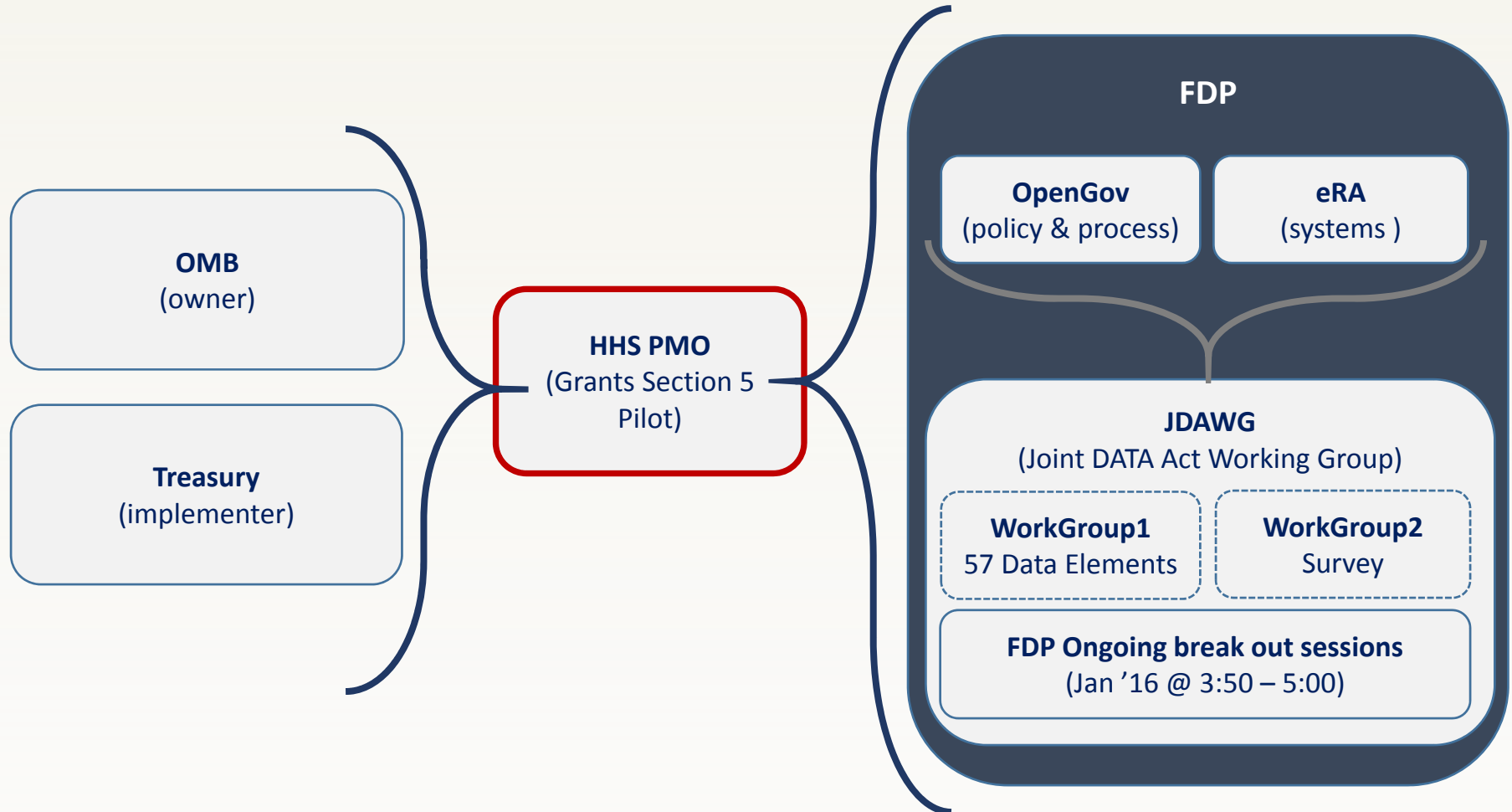

DATA Act Org Structure





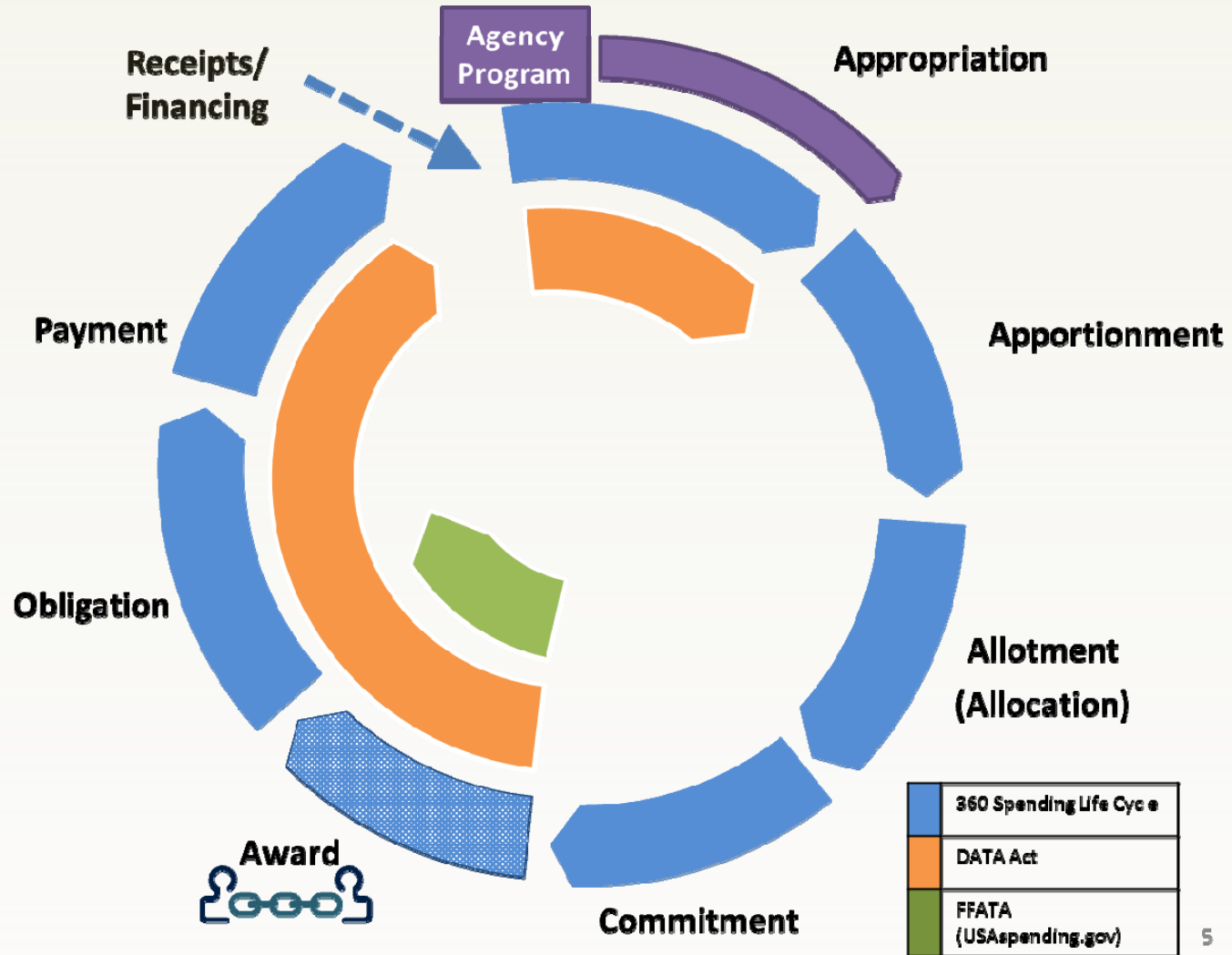

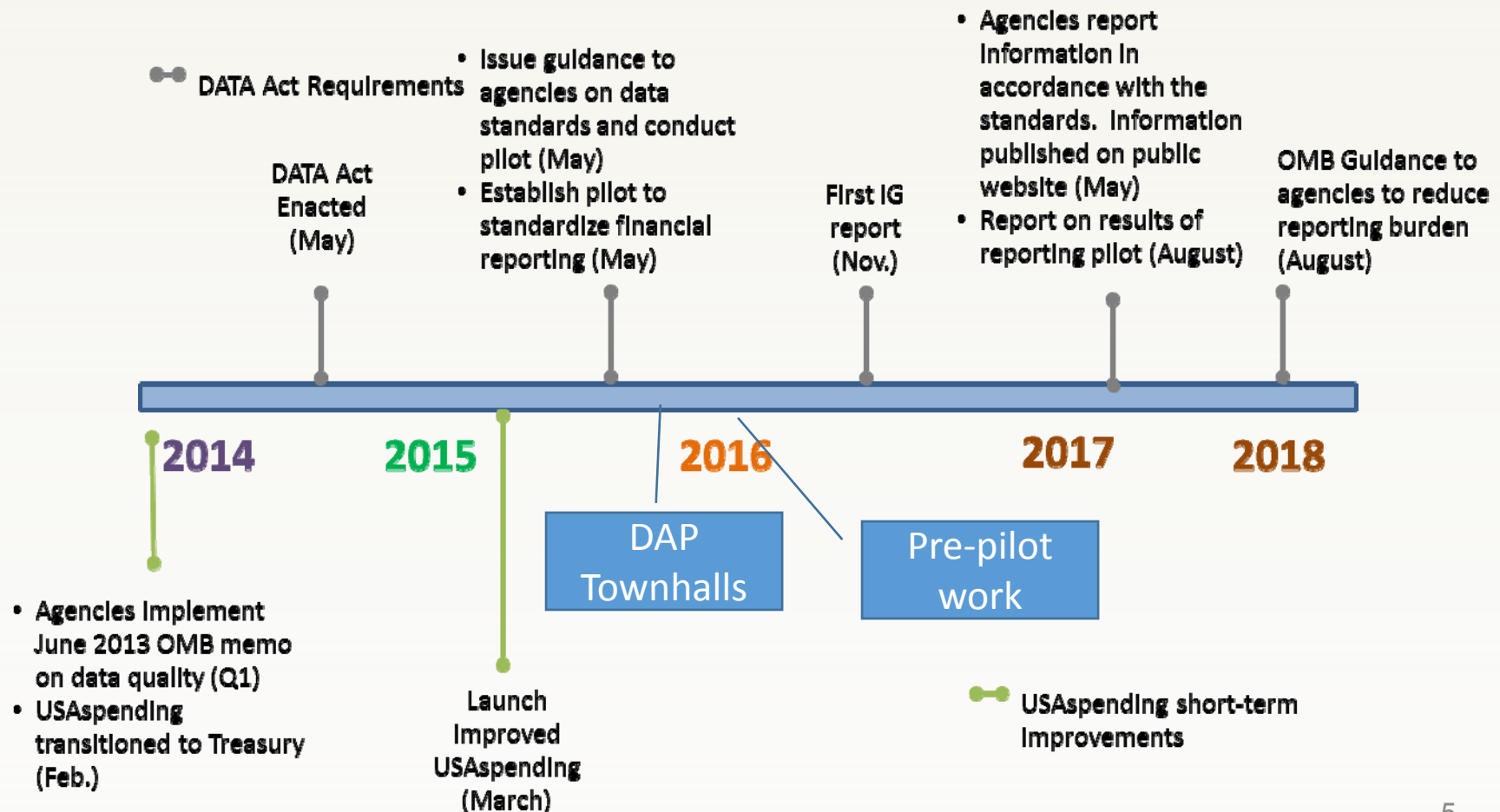
DATA Act in Context of Spending Life Cycle
