RELEASE 16.1 OVERVIEW

Release 16.1 Summary

- Release Date: 11/20/2017
- User Access Management
 - Streamline Account Creation & Login
 - Create account without restraint of organization approval
 - Allows user to create and save subscriptions
 - Register with organization later when it comes time to apply
- Subscription Management
 - View and Manage subscriptions
 - New subscription types: News and Saved Searches
 - One-Click Subscribe to Opportunity
- Workspace
 - Enhance Workspace form reuse feature to copy across form versions
 - Streamline Workspace creation
- Other Enhancements
 - Forms Repository
 - Grant Opportunity Search
 - Search by Application Package IDs

FUTURE ENHANCEMENTS

Future enhancements

- Future Release Date: 3/2018?
- Interactive discussion and collaboration forums
- Streamline Roles and Privileges
 - Allow Organizations to create custom roles
 - Move Expanded AOR from Organization level to User level
 - Modify EBiz POC Privileges
- Workspace
 - Enhance Workspace Copy
 - Add attachments to Application/Form view
 - Add error messages to Activity
- Federated Authentication

LEGACY APPLICATION PACKAGE UPDATE

Legacy PDF Application Package

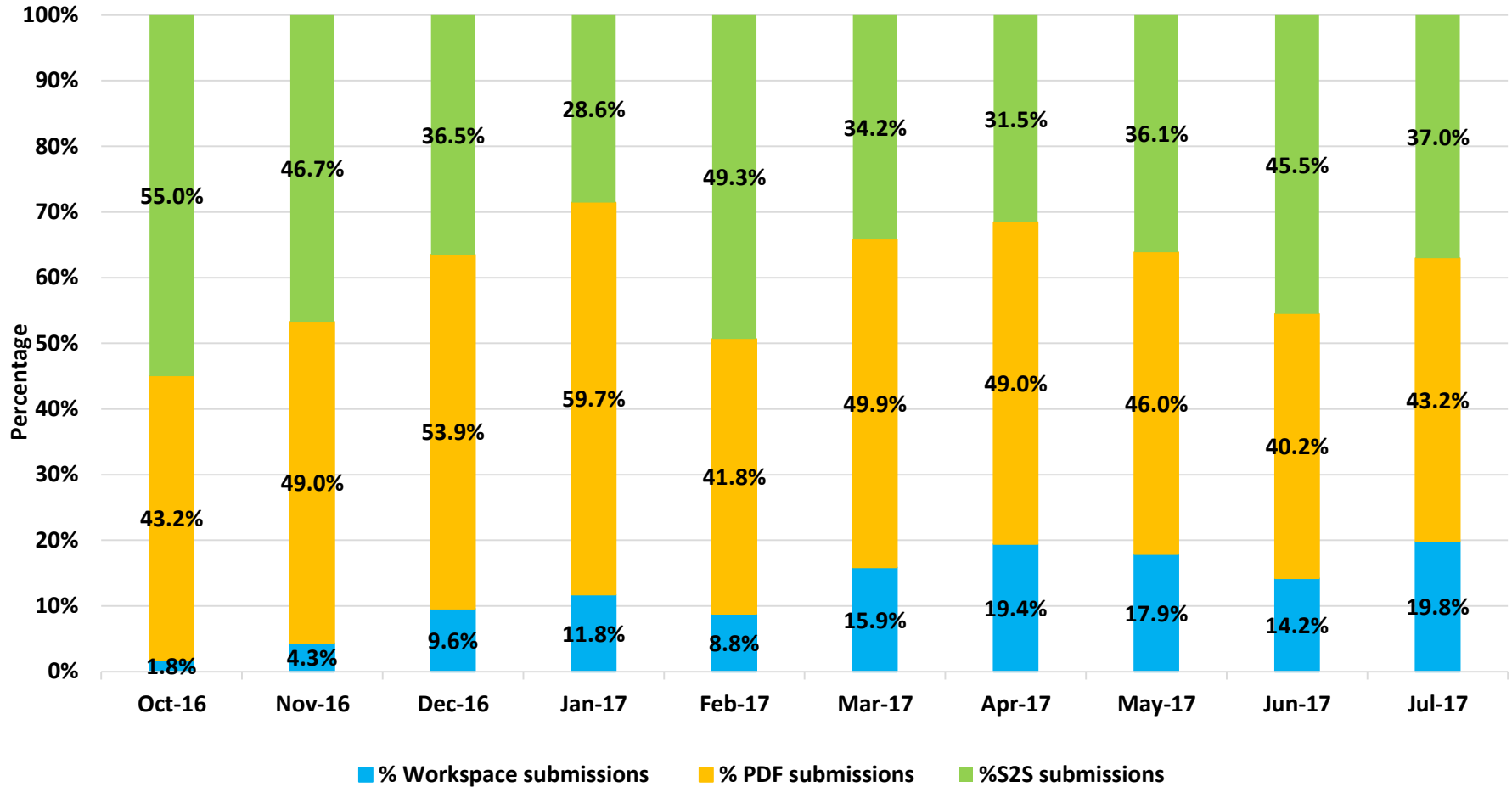
Legacy PDF Application Package will be phased out in December 31, 2017.

- Applicants will no longer be able to download the older, single PDF application package of forms.
- Applicants can apply for grants using Grants.gov Workspace, which separates the application package into individual forms. Applicants can create a workspace, complete the forms online or by filling out the separate PDF forms, and submit their application workspace package.
- The new online forms interface is now available in Grants.gov and is only accessible through Workspace.
- For any funding opportunities where applicants have downloaded the legacy PDF application package, they will be able to continue to submit that package until March 31, 2018.
- S2S Submissions will continue to be supported.

% Submissions by Method

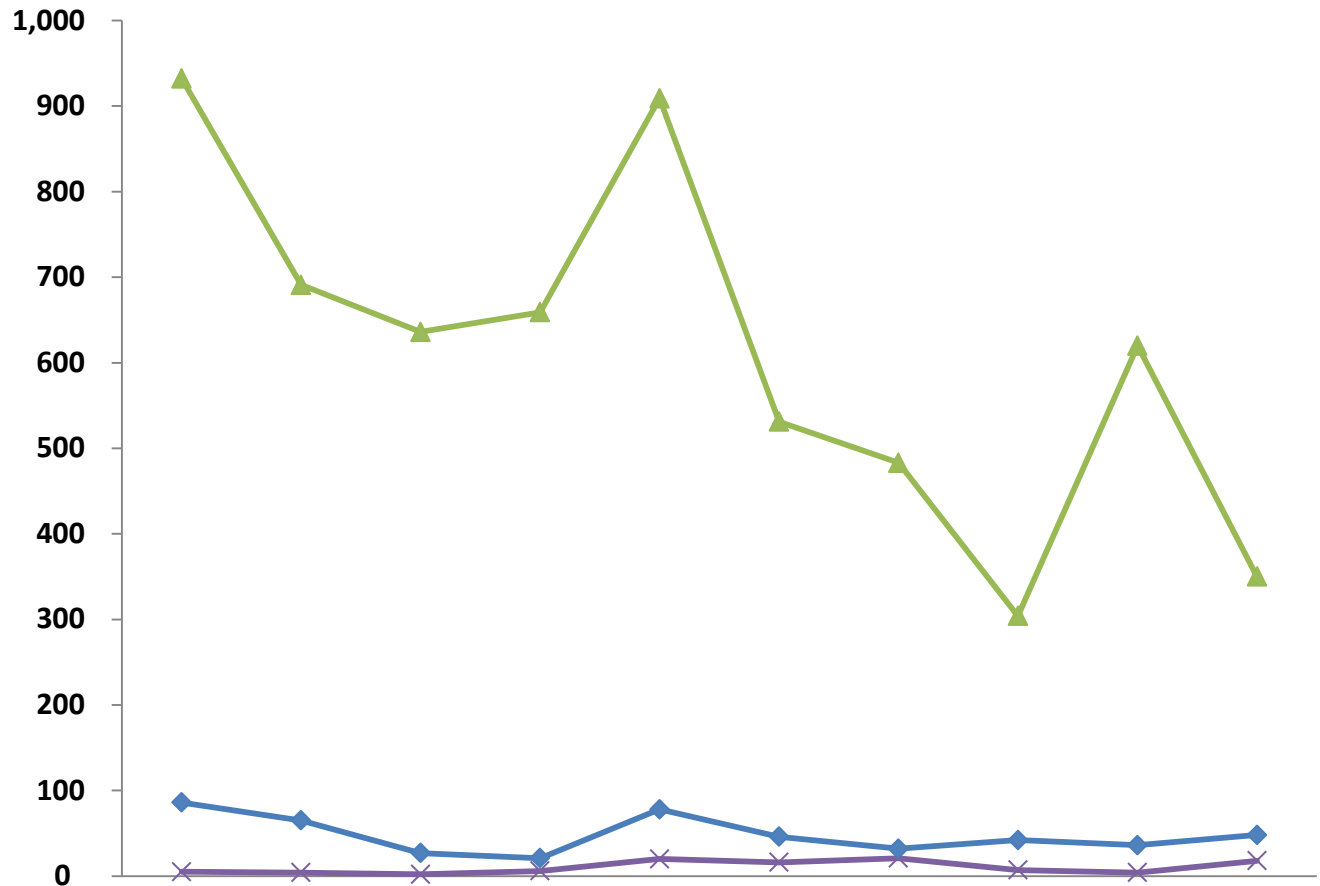
% Submissions by Method

- Error checking while applications are in-progress reduces rejections
